



Looking for Land: Building Symbols of Attachment in Sandplay Therapy

This workshop includes case material of a 10-12 year old girl who suffered attachment wounds due to unavoidable interruptions in her early attachment relationships, primarily with her mother. Basic attachment theory will be reviewed along with ways it might be applied to:

- multi-generational patterns expressed symbolically as: “loss of mothering/parenting” and “loss of land”
- unresolved and recurring trauma and its effects on a mother’s energy and attitudes
- amplification of trauma reactions (fight, flight, freeze) and the troubled behaviors of a scapegoated child

The case presentation will be followed by “how to get started” and a group consultation with case material participants bring.
